



Worship Team Criteria “Equipping Worship Leadership”

Calling - Availability - Talent

The role of a worship team member portrays a state of humble confidence which reflects a peaceful praising spirit dedicated to leading God’s people in the worship of Himself. A true worship leader gives way to the Holy Spirit’s leading and graciously submits their talent to the end of bringing Glory to God.

CALLING - Each worship team singer should exhibit a calling or passion or urging from the Holy Spirit to be a minister who desires to lead people in worship of God. One should see themselves as a conduit which God can use to facilitate the worship of Himself.

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, the apostle and high priest whom we confess.

AVAILABILITY - Each worship team singer should see themselves as a servant available to God to facilitate His worship. Singers should give time and energy to preparing the music and preparing spiritually for their opportunity to serve in leading worship. Availability means time. Ideally our lives should reflect a calm peaceful heart devoid of distractions.

John 3:30 He must increase, but I must decrease.

TALENT- Each worship team singer should possess a gifting in music ability. Participants should demonstrate an ability to memorize music, sing harmonies and assimilate new songs quickly.

1 Chron. 25:7-8 Along with their relatives--all of them trained and skilled in music for the LORD--they numbered 288. Young and old alike, teacher as well as student, cast lots for their duties.
